

REGIONAL STANDARDS COMMITTEE MINUTES

DATE: January 25, 2007

LOCATION: County Operations Center, Building 2 Conference Room

1. Tim Stanton called the meeting to order.
2. November Meeting Minutes: Meeting minutes were approved.
3. Submittal Log: Sandy distributed the new Submittal Log for April 2006-April 2009. Discussion on the items, see Submittal Log for status details, available at www.regional-stds.com under the COMMITTEE page.
4. Letter to Local Agencies – Tim reviewed the proposed letter to send to all local agencies along with County Policy I-50.
 - a. There is a public works engineer's meeting that Tim will try to get information about so that the RSC can get on a meeting agenda to discuss the standards.
 - b. City of San Diego – Mohsen reported that he is working on a City Policy and he will add this. This will be a departmental policy, not a City Council policy.
5. 2007-2009 RSC Goals – Tim will email these to Sandy for distribution to all members. Discussion on trying to have RSC member agencies taking more ownership of drawings.
6. Earl was not present to report, but Mohsen reported that at the last Greenbook Committee the discussion focused on the GB log, updating the log and workshops. The GB committee is also encouraging more participation. The Greenbook Revision Log are posted on the website <http://www.greenbookspecs.org/>
7. Mohsen's recommendation for revisions to the newly approved '2006 Regional Supplement 2006 Greenbook' were emailed out to all members. Discussion on these regarding the headings/subheadings and removal of page references. Mohsen used the GB Editorial guidelines in making these proposed revisions.

These revisions will be returned to the Editorial Committee for review and recommendations to the RSC.

8. Curb Ramps – Fletcher discussed revisions made to the City of San Diego ADA standard drawings. These were distributed via email to all members. The City is holding to the 24" x 48" size truncated domes for the standard curb ramps, referencing the State ADA standards (California Building Code and Title 24). The County of San Diego is preferring to revise the size to 36" x 48" min. truncated domes for all new curb ramps, per the standards of the State Architect for all School projects. This issue will be sent to the Roads Subcommittee for evaluation.

City has revised the material used for their truncated domes. They are now calling out for a stainless steel product.

The City of San Diego recommends that the RSC study the Standard Accessible Intersection for traffic signals. The audible component for the Walk/Don't Walk (CooCoo and Chirping) is no longer valid.

Discussion on the condition that AC overlays, in excess of 1.5", require that the curb ramps be brought up to current standards. This requires new ramps to be installed and existing ramps be retrofitted.
