

REGIONAL STANDARDS COMMITTEE

MINUTES

DATE: March 24, 2005

LOCATION: County Operations Center, Building 2

1. Tim Stanton called the meeting to order.
2. February Meeting Minutes: A motion was made to approve the meeting minutes. Motion was approved.
3. Submittal Log Status: No new submittals.
4. Tim stated that this is the last month for new submittals to be included in the next publication (2006).
5. Earl Lokers presented updates on the Greenbook Committee meeting. Earl reported on the following items:
 - a. 151NS – submitted by subcommittee, on 30 day hold.
 - b. 107-NU – submitted by subcommittee, on 30 day hold.
 - c. 128NS - submitted by subcommittee, on 30 day hold.

All will be voted on at the next meeting.

6. Earl Lokers will check the status of the Draft Specifications with chair of the Greenbook Committee. The RSD Committee is still looking for volunteers to participate in review of Draft Greenbook Specifications. Volunteers should contact Dennis Davies.
7. Discussion on Electrical and Metal Beam Guard Rail (MBGR) drawings. Perhaps replace MBGR with 1 drawing referring users to Caltran's Standard Plans.
8. Mark distributed Irrigation Drawings I-10, I-14, I-32, I-33 and Landscape Drawing L-5 for review. Note that I-10 and I-32 are new drawings. These drawings will be emailed out to all committee members prior to April RSD Meeting.
9. Jim has not received any comments on the sewer drawings out for review. **Sewer Drawing SC-01, SM-01, SM-02, SM-03, SM-04, SM-05, SM-07, SM-08, SP-01, SP-02, SP-03, SP-05, SP-07, SP-09, SS-01, SS-02, SS-03 and SS-04 were approved as submitted.**

10. Report by Subcommittee Chairs:

Editorial: Tim reported that the committee meeting focused on the Greenbook Specifications and calendar for RSD publication.

Traffic/Lighting/Electrical: Dino was not present to report.

Structures: There was no one present to report. Still looking for volunteers for the subcommittee.

Drainage/NPDES: Debbie was not present to report. Tim will check with Debbie on creating a separate section for NPDES drawings.

Roads/Streets: Dennis was not present to report.

Wet Utilities: Jim reported that there is 1 more sewer drawing to review.

Landscaping: Mark reported that the subcommittee is preparing 4 more drawings to submit for review.

11. New business items: Jim Burns came to the meeting to discuss shoring. Some local agencies are currently (randomly?) requiring California Engineering Stamps on the shoring plans. Is this going to be required for all projects? Sandy will check with County inspection staff on this issue and other members should check with their inspection staff and discuss at next RSD meeting.
