

# REGIONAL STANDARDS COMMITTEE

## MINUTES

DATE: April 28, 2005

1. Tim Stanton was not present. Sandy Brady called the meeting to order.
2. March Meeting Minutes: Earl corrected the following items:

  - 12. revise date to April 28, 2005.A motion was made to approve the meeting minutes as noted. Motion was approved.
3. Submittal Log Status: No new submittals. No new submittals will be accepted for the 2006 publication.
4. Tim was not present to report. A status list of the drawings was distributed to all present. Several drawings that have been approved are not available on the website yet. All approved drawings will be posted when drafting is complete.
5. Earl Lokers presented updates on the Greenbook Committee meeting. Earl reported on the following items:

6. Mark received comments from the City of San Diego and Escondido on the previously distributed Irrigation Drawings I-10, I-14, I-32, I-33 and Landscape Drawing L-5. L-5 will be revised and brought back to the committee next month for approval. **I-10, I-14, I-32 and I-33 were APPROVED as submitted.**

8. Report by Subcommittee Chairs:

Traffic/Lighting/Electrical: Dino distributed Section 209 of the Greenbook Specifications for Street Lights and Traffic Signals. He is looking for comments from agencies.

The Traffic Control Plans are in autoCAD, the subcommittee is beginning work on making these compatible with MUTCD.

Structures: There was no one present to report. Still looking for volunteers for the subcommittee. Dr. Rajan, the County Senior Structural Engineer is reviewing the proposal from the consultant.

Drainage/NPDES: Debbie was not present to report. Dennis Buss reported that the subcommittee did not meet.

Roads/Streets: Dennis reported that the subcommittee met and got through G-1 through G-19. When the revisions are drafted, the drawings will be brought to the RSD committee for review.

Wet Utilities: Jim was not present to report.

Landscaping: Mark reported that the subcommittee is meeting once a month now, continuing to review drawings.

9. Sandy discussed the County's Trench Shoring Inspection Requirements. Capital Improvement Projects Inspection and Land Development Inspection require Shoring Plans to meet the CALOSHA standards. A signature by a California Registered Engineer is not mandatory as long as the submitted plan meets CALOSHA standards. If a shoring plan is submitted that deviates from the standards, then a California Registration will be required on all plans and calculations.
